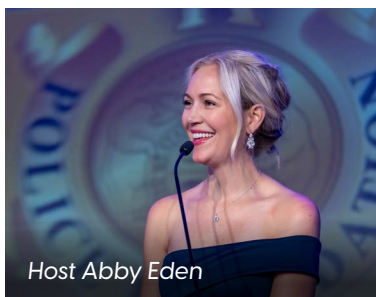

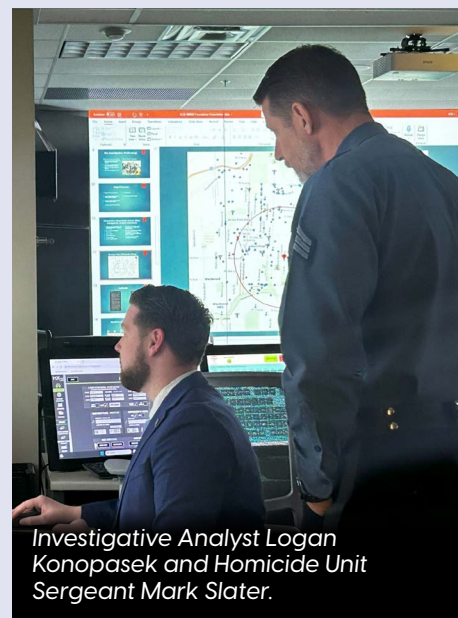

CHIEF STACEY GRAVES **ANNOUNCES** NEW KCPD **CRIME PLAN**

In an exciting development, the Kansas City Police Department, under the leadership of Chief Stacey Graves, has released a new comprehensive crime plan. This plan outlines a data-driven approach to reducing violent crime in Kansas City and focuses on the following strategies:

- Data-Informed Community Engagement (DICE)
- Data-Driven Deployment
- Focused Deterrence

The KCPD's crime plan emphasizes collaboration between KCPD and the community, highlighting the importance of working together to build a safer Kansas City. The plan also details the use of data analysis to inform crime-fighting strategies. [Read the full crime plan here.](#)

STEPPING INTO THE LINE OF DUTY: HOW VR IS TRANSFORMING KCPD TRAINING IN KANSAS CITY

The KCPD is taking a big step forward in officer training with the APEX Training Simulator, recently purchased by the Foundation through your generosity. This VR system is used extensively for both recruits and seasoned officers, allowing them to experience realistic scenarios in a safe, controlled environment. Once APEX is up and running, the KCPD will give the community a glimpse into this innovative program by inviting members of the media to test it out firsthand. This "day in the life" experience puts participants in the shoes of officers, forcing them to make split-second decisions. After the simulation, there's a crucial debriefing session where participants can discuss their choices and analyze the situation in detail. It's this post-training discussion that truly sets APEX apart, as officers learn from each other and refine their decision-making skills at the speed of life.

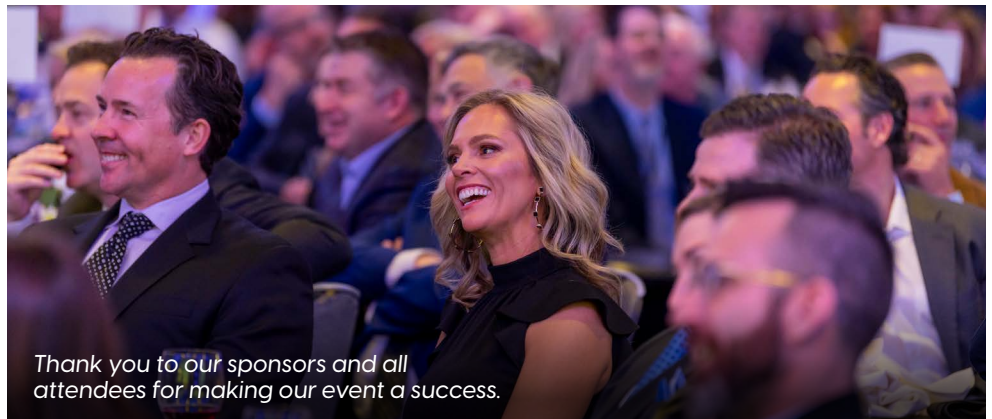
